## Commodore's Corner

Renegaders, welcome back to the winter sailing season the ponds are skimming over and we'll be on the ice before you know it! I'm hoping 2007 will be filled with great sailing and we'll build off the success of the 2006 Renegade Championship. During that well organized regatta, we had over 30 sailors competing, the wind cooperated (generally), and the ice conditions were excellent. It was a new direction for us since it marked the first time a Renegade Championship was held without the ISA. This has both bad and good effects. We lost the camaraderie and excitement that comes with sailing with the skeeter fleets, but we gained more racing time for ourselves. I think the positives may outweigh the negatives, but would like to know your thoughts on the subject; Do you prefer sailing our annual regatta independently? Or, would you prefer to sail with the ISA, when possible? Please indicate your preference on your dues submittal.

At the regatta conclusion,

several of us discussed how we could make it even better, assuming it was held independently. This drove most of the proposals for this year's annual meeting agenda (see page 4). Item #1 keeps the seven race format, but allows up to four races per day on Sat and Sun so we could make up races that may have been missed on the previous day(s). It would also allow us to complete the regatta with only one day of sailing on either Sat or Sun, which is similar to the format used by the ISA and NIYA. Items 2 & 3 reflect the wishes of some to sail more races. I don't really have a preference for 7, 9, or 11 races but these proposals, at least, allows us all to make the decision together. Item 4 allows for one throw-out to be used during our annual regatta. This method has been used successfully by other fleets as well as the 4LIYC. Items 5 & 6 are administrative details that are needed if we hold our own regattas. The wording for each was copied directly from the ISA "Conditions of Race". Lastly, item 7 covers the terms served

by our Board members. Currently, the Board will "turn-over" at the conclusion of our annual regatta or May 1, if the regatta was not completed. This proposal would change the "turn-over" date to May 1 regardless of regatta completion. This would make our leadership more consistent since we'd have one group of board members lead our class for the full sailing season rather than have two groups. For example, in 2006, our regatta was completed in early January, thus forcing the board to turn-over and preventing the previous board from serving the full season.

Making our class run is a team effort and I encourage each of you to lend a hand. One of the best ways to help is to join us at the annual meeting and participate in the discussion. We really want your input on how to make things operate as smoothly as possible.

I'm looking forward to seeing you on the ice. Best wishes to you and your family during the holiday season!

Mary Jane would then relay info back to Deb, giving us up to the minute regatta standings. I don't remember being at a better run regatta than that and there's no reason it can't be repeated in 2007. I hope to see you there.

# IRIYA Championship

**2007 Notice of Race**

- The IRIYA is normally held in conjunction with the ISA regatta. There is a very strong possibility the IRIYA regatta will be held independently of the ISA regatta.
- All races will be sailed under the rules of the National Iceboat Authority and those of the International Renegade Ice Yacht Association.
- The regatta will be scheduled on January 5, 6 and 7, 2007. The first race will be held at 10:00 AM (local time) on Friday, January 5, 2007. In the event the IRIYA regatta is postponed, the IRIYA regatta will not be scheduled on the same weekend as the Northwest Ice Yacht Association (NIYA) regatta. The NIYA regatta will take precedence.
- Awards shall be given to the yachts placing first through sixth.
- Entry fee is \$15.00 per yacht payable upon registration.
- Registration will be at regatta headquarters from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM (local time) on Friday, January 5, 2007
- **Five** (5) races are scheduled and **three** (3) are necessary to complete the regatta. If the IRIYA regatta is held separately from the ISA regatta, there will be **seven** (7) races scheduled and **four** (4) races are necessary to complete the regatta.
- Skippers may obtain sailing instructions at the time of registration.
- For confirmation of the regatta dates, the primary source of information will be the IRIYA web site ([www.iceboat.org/renegade.htm](http://www.iceboat.org/renegade.htm)) beginning at 1:00 PM CST on December 31, 2006. For final confirmation go to website after 1:00 PM CST on January 3, 2007. If computer access is unavailable, the secondary source of information will be the Renegade Hotline number (641-985-5999, Ext. 19158) beginning at 1:00 PM CST on December 31, 2006. Information as to the site, headquarters, and accommodations will be available at 1:00 PM CST on January 3, 2007. Members of the Race Committee can also provide regatta information. # Minutes of 2006 IRIYA Annual Meeting

Fond du Lac, WI: Microtel Inn & Suites

1. Meeting called to order by Commodore Andy McCormick at 6:30 pm.
2. Roll Call: Andy McCormick, Ron Rosten, Robert Pagel, Archie Call, Greg McCormick, Tim McCormick, Don Anderson, Clay Georgeson, Glenn Betzoldt, Ken Norton, George Gerhardt, Dan Hearn, Wes Wilcox and Marc Zuhlke.
3. Financial Report unanimously approved as mailed in December 2005. Motion/second - Tim McCormick/Don Anderson.
4. Minutes from previous meeting were approved with the exception of section 6.9 which should be changed from "6 instead of 5 trophies to be awarded at our championship regatta" to correctly read "8 instead of 5 trophies to be awarded at our championship regatta". Motion/second - Tim McCormick/Ken Norton.
5. Unfinished Business: None
6. New Business:
  - 6.1. From Robert Pagel: Article XV, Section 1: Delete, "in the event of a tie, the tie shall be broken in favor of the yacht that has beaten the other the greater number of times". Replace with, "In the event of a tie, the tie shall be broken in favor of the yacht with the greater number of first place finishes, then second place finishes, etc." Motion/second - Tim McCormick/Don Anderson. Motion passes unanimously.
  - 6.2. From Robert Pagel: Article XV, Section 1: Computation of points. Delete "Yachts scoring Did Not Start (DNS), Did Not Finish (DNF), and Disqualified (DSQ), shall be awarded points equal to the number of competing yachts plus one point". Replace with, "Yachts scoring Did Not Start (DNS), Did Not Finish (DNF), and Disqualified (DSQ), and Retired After Finishing (RAF) shall be awarded points equal to the number of competing yachts plus one point". Motion/second - Andy McCormick/Ken Norton. Motion passes unanimously.
  - 6.3. From Ron Rosten: Article X, Section 2: These motions shall be: Delete, "mailed to the paid members prior to the annual meeting", Replace with "either mailed to the paid members prior to the annual meeting or posted on the official IRIYA website." Motion/second - Tim McCormick/Ken Norton. Motion passes unanimously.
  - 6.4. From Jerry Simon: Article IX, Add Section7: The board of directors (Commodore, Vice Commodore, 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Director, 1<sup>st</sup> Year Director, Secretary-Treasurer, Past Commodore) and any appointed committee member can only serve the IRIYA in one position or capacity. Commodore Andy McCormick brought up the fact that he had posted an announcement on the IRIYA website requesting Technical and Race Committee volunteers and nobody had stepped forward. He felt it was unrealistic to place limits on anyone generous enough to volunteer their time, which is what he felt the proposal would do. The Commodore then called for a motion and none were offered. Proposal does not pass.
  - 6.5. From Robert Pagel: Article XV, Section 2: An over 60 Master Competitor shall declare their intent at the time of registration. Motion to amend original proposal to replace "Master Competitor shall declare their intent at time of registration" to "Master Competitor should declare their intent at time of registration". The reason for the amendment was to allow skipper the choice to compete for the Master trophy rather than mandating a skipper over 60 to sail for Master trophy. Amendment motion/second - Tim McCormick/Andy McCormick. Amendment passes unanimously. Original motion/second - Greg McCormick/Tim McCormick. Motion passes unanimously.
  - 6.6. Discussion Item #1: Trophy Chairman Robert Pagel has 8 blank trophies available, suggests using trophies for a second regatta this winter to be sailed for at the ISA or Western ISA. A poll of members present favors the recommendation.
  - 6.7. Discussion Item #2: 7 Race format. Tim McCormick brought up the possibility of allowing 4 races to be sailed on the last day of a 7 race regatta in the event a day is lost. Dan Hearn took the discussion one step further and asked how the organization felt about a 12 race regatta. There was no clear resolution to the discussion items that were brought up.
7. Election of officers for the following year. From the Nominating Committee: Dan Hearn to be appointed the 1<sup>st</sup> year Director, Jim LaFortune to be appointed the 2<sup>nd</sup> year Director. Ron Rosten will continue as Secretary/Treasurer for 2 more years or the remainder of Greg Whitehorse's original 5 year term. Tim McCormick will advance to the position of Commodore and Andy McCormick will become Past Commodore. Motion/second - Ken Norton/Greg McCormick. Motion passes unanimously.
8. Discussion Item #3: Allowing placement of a sail window. Dan Hearn asked if it would be possible to change rules to allow the use of a window in a Renegade sail to improve visibility. Robert Pagel stated that class rules prevent film from being introduced and stressed the importance of maintaining class integrity. Bob also discussed the fact that the DN's use windows to enhance the shape of their sails and suggests if windows are pursued it be nailed down to a specific size and location. Dan said he would contact a few sail makers and see what they would recommend.
9. Motion for adjournment. Motion/second - Greg McCormick/Don Anderson. Motion carries. Meeting adjourns at 7:40 pm.

### 6.1. Article IX, Section 1:

**Change:** “Each existing Board member will move up in rank and the Past Commodore from the previous year will drop off after the completion of that year’s annual regatta. (Or, if the annual regatta was not completed that year, as of May 1st of the year in which the annual meeting was held) ”

**To:** “Each existing Board member will move up in rank and the Past Commodore from the previous year will drop off as of May 1st of the year in which the annual meeting was held.”

**Rationale:** This allows the Board to stay intact during the entire winter sailing season. For example, if the annual regatta is held in early January, it would make sense for the Board to handle any remaining issues for that sailing season, rather than hand over the management of the association to a new Board mid-season. ### 6.5. Article XIII, Section 6:

**Add:** If 0-6 races are completed, no throw-outs are allowed. If 7 or more races are completed, then 1 throw-out is allowed. A sailor's worst race finish, including DNC, DNF, DSQ, and RAF is eligible for throw-out. Submitted by Tim McCormick – Renegade #385

### 6.6. Article XV, Scoring:

#### Add:

-DNS, DNF, and DSQ shall score points equal to one more than the number of yachts competing.

-For scoring purposes only, the finish position of a yacht being disqualified will be filled by moving the other yachts up.

-Added yachts will readjust the previous day's fleet size for scoring purposes. Submitted by Tim McCormick – Renegade #385

### 6.7. Add to Sailing Instructions:

**Starting Positions:** Starting positions for a yacht for the first race shall be determined by random drawing conducted by the Race Committee or designee. Starting positions thereafter shall be by the yacht's finishing position in the previous race. The finish position of a yacht being disqualified will not be filled by moving the other yachts up.

**Last Day Time:** If the minimum number of races to complete the regatta has been achieved, no race shall start after 1:00 PM, local time. Submitted by Tim McCormick – Renegade #385

### 6.8. Article XIII

**Add:** Section 13. The race committee may move the regatta site if it becomes unsafe or conditions change enough to prevent the completion of the IRIYA Championship regatta. If the regatta site is moved, all yachts concerned shall be notified as to the date, time, and place of the next race. The race committee is advised not to make participants travel through dangerous weather conditions to reach the new site. Submitted by Ron Rosten – Renegade #19


